

Background Reasoning

A relatively optimistic estimate is that we have five million persons, nationwide, who are willing to 'show up' for effective, responsive actions for causes at least eight hours per month, roughly two hours per week on average. So for Michigan, we would have a total body pool 100,000 x 8 or 800,000 person-hours per month. We can break that down conservatively by county—Michigan has roughly 80 counties—so worst case for, say, Oakland County would be 10,000 warm body person-hours.

If we build it, people will step up

We would launch a WBL organization statewide, and similarly at the county levels. Then set priority support activities for organizations who use the WBL program. Let's say we have 10 such organizations, including a 'smart' meter activist group, a geoengineering assaults group, general corruption fighting groups, and so on. On the other panel we look at a specific example, Georgetta's court case, which came up in October 2016.

Believe me now and hear me later, even 100 warm bodies in support before any local public body yields *significant* pressure on those public officials!

The Basic Idea

Warm Bodies for Liberty (WBL) is an organized pool of liberty persons who commit to ACT, and then ACT, by mainly SHOWING UP ... in public settings

- a. to stand for those being bashed by the corrupt legal system and
- b. to work person-to-person for initiatives that restore people's freedoms.

Priority issues requiring major warm body support are dictated by ~7-12 Threats imposed by the Men of the Power Sickness.

A sample scenario re: 'smart' meters.

- 1) In October 2016, an Oakland County court was to decide whether a homeowners' association may compel 'Georgetta' to install a 'smart' meter or force her to pay its fines.
- 2) WBL has grown to 100,000 'Liberty bodies (LBs),' Michiganders who commit 8 hrs. per month of showing up => 10,000 LBs for Oakland County.
- 3) The word comes from the WBL leadership to support Georgetta at court to the amount of 200 persons for 4 hrs.
- 4) With WBL county and state LBs, a total of 400 persons (!) shows up at the Oakland County Courthouse, overflowing the courtroom and getting major media coverage, also handing out information outside.
- 5) The judge/jury denies homeowners claims, enjoins DTE to restore power to Georgetta via a safe analog meter.

Public pressure => official reasonableness.

Warm Bodies for Liberty

"Many Hands Make Light Work"

This idea to distribute the work load for maximum results needs to become a MISSION especially among the liberty people. We cannot afford less than our best effort for liberty—those who would take it from us will grant no quarter.

Public officials are moved to do the right thing by *pressure*.

We need a simple system to put warm bodies at the pressure points of city council meetings, hearings, court watchings, letter writings, petitioning, pamphletting, campaigning, supporting important causes in general, etc.

The 'Warm Body' System

The adage about showing up, most often attributed to Woody Allen, expresses a profound truth especially germane to achieving benign political goals. How many times have you joined a group of people working to end some aggression of the state—in court, on the streets petitioning, attending or speaking before your city council meetings, and so on—and the total entourage numbers three individuals!?

Way too many times, I'll wager. It's totally discouraging. No one wants to go to the ramparts alone. This has to stop. We need to bring masses of bodies to bear on government crime and corruption. So what does this WBL organization look like and how do we launch it?

The simpler the better, naturally. A group of us—may as well start here in Michigan—get together, establish goals and objectives, write some bylaws, create a Website, etc. Then duplicate throughout the US... eventually other countries, as well. Since this is initially my basketball, let me propose that the organization adhere to the following key concepts:

1. **Purpose of organization:** provide 'warm bodies' (usually physical presence) to stand up against priority specific acts of government aggression.... Cultivate and support affiliate organizations fighting for justice against corporate-government assaults.

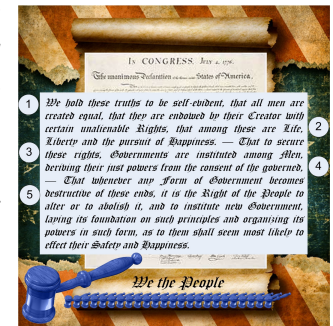

2. **Participants will be members**, this will be a membership-supported organization, with a small dues of \$10-\$20 per year.
3. **Organizations who wish to access WBL support** will be special members, as well, perhaps paying a yearly fee; envision ~20 longstanding org-members.
4. **Individuals being aggressed against** by corrupt power may request WBL services free of charge using standard forms.
5. **All funds collected by WBL** will be used to run the organization and pay for materials and resources integral to its objectives.
6. **Priority actions will be set by a leadership council**, initially composed of those who founded the organization; bylaws set up how 'private' the organization will be; membership input to WBL control will exist.
7. **Individual members are participants** who commit to so many hours per month of support to action-options provided by leadership; awards, recognition, incentives encourage activity... and new members.
8. **WBL shall be rife with pride symbols**—tokens of participation, exceptional activism—including pins, buttons, stickers, t-shirts, emblems of various kinds that proudly display a member's active support.

9. **Types of activities for WBL members** include court watching, petitioning, pamphleting, door-to-door canvassing, city council meeting attendance, state government body monitoring, writing letters and making phone calls to officials, and so on... **SHOWING UP.**
10. **WBL will become the platform for enabling common sense, First Principles' independent grand juries** to investigate and indict gross public-official misconduct; in fact WBL shall be two-sided in its approach—initially serving to assemble the warm bodies typically in defensive fashion to protect victimized individuals from the state, yet going on the offensive quickly to catalyze people's grand jury justice... vs. public officials and their associates who violate their oaths and/or engage in gross criminal acts against the people
